Chapter 3: Getting started with Standard and Enterprise Versions

The Standard and Enterprise versions offer a full lifecycle management of your Meter reading teams. A designated administrator can add and manage users within the company. Adding users will allow the users to practice and take Meter Reading tests. The Administrator can control what practice and assessment/test options are available globally within the company and can over-ride the options for specific users. A full history of previous tests and practices and scores attained is maintained and the Administrator has access to previous practices and test score cards/grade reports. The Administrator can also be set-up to receive alerts and reports when users complete their practices and tests.

Ready to purchase a license for the Standard or Enterprise version? If yes, please contact us via the 'Contact Us' option on the Meterbyte Main Web Page. The Standard and Enterprise version both come up with a yearly subscription only. Please contact us and we will price the costs for you. The cost is calculated on a base + per user price.

Once you are ready to sign-on, we will enable a company administrator to login to MeterByte and set-up the company details, global preferences, add users and other administrators and set-up user preferences.

Chapter 4: Organization/Company Setup

- The company set-up is usually completed once. MeterByte support team will set-up a Company Administrator once you sign up. MeterByte support team will also set-up the base Company details.
- Upon first time login to MeterByte, you will see the Company Set-up Web Page for your Company/Organization.

Chapter 5: Add administrator's and Users (User Settings screen)

Add Administrators:

Add Administrators to the company. Only administrators can add other administrators and non-admin users. Only administrators can set global and user preferences.

Please note that administrators are not able to take meter reading practices and tests. Only users can. The administrators can receive a copy of the users results if required. The administrators can also access previous practices and tests that have been completed by the user,

Add Users

Add users to the company. Once users are added, they will be able to login and take practices and assessment tests. The user will be notified via email to activate their account before they can login.

Delete Icon

The delete icon will remove the user from the company and the user will no longer be able to login.

Edit Icon

The edit icon allows the administrator to issue a new password to the user.

User Preferences Icon

Set user preferences which will override global preferences for the user. For more details, please refer to User Preferences Section below.

Chapter 6: Set-up Organization/Company Preferences

Following is a view of the Company Preferences screen. This Company Preferences screen is only available to administrators of a company.



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Dials:

Type of Dials available to users for practice or assessments within the company.



Check to allow and un-check to disable the use of the type of dial within practices and assessments.

Level

The levels available for practices and assessments

Mode

Allow users to practice and take assessment tests. Uncheck if one does not apply.

Number of Questions:

This is the number of questions available to users within the company when practicing or taking assessments tests. Minimum is 10 and maximum is 100.

Time for tests:

The total time allowed for assessment tests. For assessments tests, the timer will count down and once time is up, the test will end regardless if the user had completed answering all questions or not.

Time for practices:

The total time allowed for practices. The timer will count down and once time is up, the practice will end regardless if the user had completed answering all questions or not

Pass Grade

The pass grade configured with the company. User must achieve this grade to pass. Maximum is 100 and minimum is 0.

Grade Reports

Once practice or assessments are completed, these options if checked will generate grade reports.

Historical Reports

Keep historical grade reports

Shuffle

Questions are randomized/shuffled for practices and assessment tests, if



Email Grade Reports

If checked, all grade reports links are emailed to the administrator(s) once user has completed practices or tests.

Chapter 7: Set-up User Preferences

Following is a view of the User Preferences screen. The User Preferences screen is only available to administrators of a company. Please note that any options checked or unchecked will <u>only apply</u> to the user and will override global preferences that have been set for the company.

The first section of the User Dashboard provides the following metrics:

Total Tests Taken:

This is the number of tests that user has taken to date **Total Practices Taken:** This is the number of practices the user has taken. **Total Beginner Tests Taken:** This is the number of all Beginner level tests taken by the user **Total Intermediate Test Taken** This is the number of all Intermediate level tests taken by the user. **Total Advanced Level Test Taken** This is the number of all Advanced level tests taken by the user. **Average Test Score** The average pass rate of all tests taken by the user.

The **second section** of the user Dashboard provides the user with the options for starting practices or taking tests. The options presented here are driven by the global and user preferences that are set by the administrator.

The **third section** of the User Dashboard provides a view of the global preferences set-up by the administrator of the company that will apply to the practices or tests taken by the user.

The **last, fourth section** of the User Dashboard list all the practices and tests taken by the user to date. (Not shown)



Chapter 10: Company Dashboard



The Company Dashboard provide Company/Organization wide metrics. The Company dashboard is specific to each Company and is only viewable by the Administrator.

The first section of the Company Dashboard provides the following metrics:

Total Enrolled users:

This is the number of users registered in the company who can practice and/or take assessments for Meter Reading

Total Tests Taken:

This is the number of all tests taken in the company to-date by enrolled users.

Total Practices Taken:

This is the number of all practices taken in the company to-date by enrolled users.

Highest Grade:

This is the highest grade achieved by at least one user in the company. This grade is specific to tests only.

Pass Rate:

The average pass rate of all tests taken in the company. These metrics are further broken down by level (Beginner, Intermediate and Advanced) and dial type (as shown)

The **third section** provides a view of the global preferences set-up by the administrator of the company. (not shown)

The **Global preferences** are applied globally to all users within the company. Global preferences can be over-ridden by **User Preferences** if set by the administrator.

Chapter 11: Reports

The report card has the following sections

- 1. **About me:** First and last name of the practice/test taker and their company name.
- 2. **Test Details**: Lists the type of practices and tests taken, i.e. mode (test or practice, Level (Beginner, Intermediate or Advanced and the number of dials (if analog test/practice was taken)
- 3. **Results:** Lists the # of questions attempted, total number of questions, score attained and pass/fail based on pass average specified by the administrator.

Chapter 13: Practice Screen for Analog



Practice mode allows you to practice meter reading. When in practice mode, when an incorrect meter reading is entered, the system will display the correct reading. The timer will continue to run until you complete all the questions or end the practice. A grade report, with the score will be shown upon the conclusion of the practice or if practice was ended.

In the test mode, no answers will be shown, even if the incorrect reading was entered. No option to stop the test until completed.

A tampering record is logged if the user doesn't complete the tests and attempts to use the browser back button.

Chapter 16: Assign Tests

The Standard and Enterprise versions offer the option to assign meter reading tests to staff or to users registered under the organization. A designated administrator can assign a type of meter reading test with due dates. Due dates can be optional. The user will be notified via email that the administrator has assigned a meter reading test. The test will be available on the user's dashboard. Once the test has been completed by the user, the administrator will be notified of the test completion and test results will be available on the company dashboard. User Search Search by Last Name
